Inner Wheel Club of Kuala Lumpur Scholarship Programme - Awards Presentation & 10th Anniversary Celebrations

“Education is the key to a whole new world of opportunities for our youth, and it is our firm commitment to assist deserving students for a chance to better their lives and the lives of their families. The long term value and sustainability of education cannot be over emphasized, as education will in time, eventually and inevitably, break the poverty cycles of the families.”

In the bigger picture “Education is one of the foundation of and the underlying key driver of the economic growth of a country”.

With that as the vision, this year IWCKL jointly with SEGI University & Colleges, presented scholarships for the 3-years diploma studies to four promising young students.

The objective of this joint community project is to provide the necessary tertiary education to deserving and needy students to enable them to have better opportunities for employment in the job market.

Applications are opened to students with a minimum of 5 credits in the SPM examinations. In addition, the family income must not be more than RM3,000 per month.

This is the 10th year that the Club has carried out this Scholarship Programme. To date, inclusive of this year’s 4 students, a total of 43 students have been sponsored for the diploma studies.

The total value of this year’s programme for the four scholarships is RM133,400.00, of which SEGi University & College’s sponsorship for the full tuition fees for the 4 diploma studies is RM113,300, while IWCKL takes care of the total Registration and Misc Fees of RM20,100.00.

Mr Wong Chee Kong, Registrar of SEGi University & Colleges, presented certificates of the Scholarship Awards to the successful students. As a token of appreciation for the 10 years of sponsoring the tuition fees for the students, President Monica presented a crystal plaque, to SEGi University & Colleges.

As part of the 10th Anniversary celebrations, two pioneer past students were invited to present the stories of their success. Miss Kiveeyhashini Govindasamy and Mr Sai Hari Ram were both Dean’s List Diploma graduates and had subsequently won further scholarships. Both graduated with First Class honours in Chemical Engineering from University Teknologi Petronas. Today, they are successful engineers in their own fields.

A photo slides presentation was shown featuring the ten years’ awards presentations and activities of the Scholarship Programme. It was indeed a walk down memory lane for the past students and IWCKL past presidents who revisited their year of participation. A commemorative note book, made from recycled paper, was given to all members and guests.
